

SPALDING WOODS CLUB SWIMMING POOL RULES

DEFINITIONS:

Child: Any person 16 years of age or younger in the household of a member
Adult: Any person 17 years of age or older in the household of a member
Guest: Any person not a member of the club

GENERAL:

1. Members must sign in and register guests prior to pool admittance.
2. Guests must be accompanied by a member for the duration of their visit.
3. Children of members are limited to 2 guests per visit when unaccompanied by an adult member.
4. Guest fees will be billed at the end of the club's fiscal year. Guest fees are:
 - a. \$1.00 per day per guest
 - b. Only overnight out-of-town guests are exempted from guest fees.
5. Members are held responsible for their guest's conduct while visiting the club.
6. Vandalism will be prosecuted.
7. Pets are **not** allowed inside the pool enclosure.
8. Glass containers are not permitted within pool enclosure.
9. Trash must be disposed of properly.
10. Climbing any fence enclosing pool is prohibited.

POOL SAFETY:

1. Children under the age of 8 are not permitted in the pool enclosure unless accompanied by an adult, or person at least 12 years of age deemed responsible by the child's parent or guardian.
2. Children under the age of 3 are not permitted in the main pool unless accompanied by an adult.
3. Children over the age of 5 are not permitted in the wading pool. Children in the wading pool must be supervised by an adult.

4. Running is not allowed within the pool enclosure.
5. The use of the diving board by children is at the discretion of the life guards.
6. Only adults are allowed in the main pool during the time known as "ADULT SWIM."
7. Life guards have the responsibility for pool safety.
8. Life guards, members of the swimming pool committee, and Board of Directors members have the authority to remove from the pool area any violator of pool rules. The aforementioned parties may recommend to the Board of Directors the suspension of chronic violators.

PRIVATE FACILITY USAGE:

Provisions for private usage of the pool and/or pool enclosure are as follows:

1. Requests must be made in writing to Mark McGuire (770-512-8150) **14 days** before the requested reservation date. The request must provide the following information:
 - a. Member's name and phone number(s)
 - b. Date, starting and ending time of the party
 - c. Number of people scheduled to attend
 - d. General age of the group
 - e. Type of function
 - f. Specific wording of invitations
 - g. A completed Sears Pool Management Consultants' *Customer Pool Party Request Form* must be submitted. These may be obtained at www.searspool.com.
2. Member must be present during the entire event.
3. Member is held personally responsible and liable for any and all actions, conduct, damages, injuries to the property and people.
4. Functions may **not** begin earlier than 7 p.m. and must end prior to 12:00 midnight.
5. Cost: A deposit payable to Spalding Woods Club, Inc. is required with the written request. Number of required lifeguards is defined by Sears Pool Management Consultants, our pool facilities management company.
 - parties of 25 or less - \$250 (includes \$100 usage fee, 1 lifeguard fee, clean-up and damage deposit)
 - parties between 26 and 60 - \$350 (includes \$100 usage fee, 2 lifeguard fees, clean-up and damage deposit)
 - parties exceeding 60 - contact Pool Operations Chairperson for cost and deposit figures.

(Any money in excess of costs will be returned.)

6. Member is required to provide one adult chaperone for every 10 people attending a teenage or college age party.
7. Fraternity and/or sorority parties of any kind are **not** permitted.
8. Cancellations are required 48 hours in advance of reservation and will be subject to SWC costs. SWC will make every effort to minimize costs on your behalf.

RULES FOR PARTIES DURING REGULAR POOL HOURS:

1. Parties of six or more guests must be **approved by Mark McGuire (770-512-8150), at least 48 hours in advance**. See additional rules below for parties of 20 or more.
2. All GENERAL Swimming Pool Rules apply, as provided in directory, with the exception of #4: if # of guests is 10 or over, a check must be left with the head lifeguard or board representative for guest fees (payable to Spalding Woods Club, Inc.).
3. All POOL SAFETY Rules apply, as provided in directory, with the exception of parties of 20 persons or more; regardless of age (see Swimming Pool Rules: Definitions and Pool Safety, #6) all party guests must clear the pool during "Adult Swim" periods, as called by lifeguards, so that regular members may swim laps, etc.
4. When hosting a party, only two picnic tables may be reserved (if they are available). Regular members have the right to tables already occupied. Hosts should also try to contain party to one area of pool.
5. Parties of 20 persons or more must leave a damage deposit check in the amount of \$250 with the head lifeguard or Pool Operations Board Member prior to admission of guests. The check will be returned to member by the following day, after inspection of the pool area.
6. All members hosting parties of 20 persons or more (not to exceed 50 persons) must pay Spalding Woods Club, Inc. for extra lifeguards. **This requires approval by the Pool Director and Sears Pool Management Consultants, our pool facilities management company, seven days prior to the party.** A completed Sears Pool Management Consultants' Customer *Pool Party Request Form* must be submitted. These may be obtained at www.searspool.com.
7. Member is required to provide one adult chaperone for every 10 people attending a teenage or college age party.
8. Lifeguards are NOT responsible for trash pick-up after parties. Members (hosts) are responsible for leaving the pool, pool deck and bathrooms in clean condition.
9. To maintain goodwill among members, hosts should encourage their guests to offer lounges and chairs to regular members.
